



Red Honor Cord Program

Small Act. Big Impact. Donate Blood.

Those between the ages of 16 and 22 are automatically opted into earning points. It is the student's responsibility to check with their school to confirm if wearing a cord is acceptable for graduation ceremonies.

Students will earn 100 points per donation. Points are awarded the day after a donation (even for deferrals), at 12:30pm. Once the student reaches 400 points, they can submit a request for their honor cord!

Instructions for the Donor Portal:

Create an account on the Donor Portal, if you don't already have one. To do this, you'll need your donor ID. Get started at donate.bloodworksnw.org. 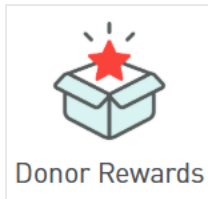
